A distinctive wine with elegance and complexity.

Characteristics

The wine offers a beautiful deep red colour. The nose is very elegant. It expands scents of raspberries, well-matured cherries and spices. The mouth is fresh, refined and very elegant.

Terroir

There are two parcels: Les Rouges du Bas et Les Quartiers de Nuits, both with a deep soil consisting of gravel and silt.

Origin

Echezeaux derives from the Latin word for "buildings," thus revealing the presence of gallo-roman ruins. Jeanne and André Mugneret acquired Les Quartiers de Nuits in 1930, and added Les Rouges du Bas in 1934.

Ageing

From five to twenty years. It is one of three grand crus that will be appreciated the most rapidly. Serve with: beef filet in mushroom pastry crust, duck confit, truffle omelette...
